**NOTE:** New Works Festival Shows will usually rehearse at least once a week. The above dates and times show all of the possible rehearsal times and do not represent the actual rehearsal schedule. The rehearsal schedule will be made by the director in coordination with the actors' schedules. You should have a least 3-4 rehearsals before the reading - usually one per week. A rehearsal may also be scheduled on the day of the reading before the call time. There will be a talk-back after the readings that actors and directors are required to be at.
